We will travel from Austin through the towns of Lockhart, Luling, Gonzales, then over the northern most rolling hills of the Hochheim Prairie to the center of Czech country, Shiner. Following lunch at the Shiner Restaurant in the historic Green Building and check-in at one of the lovely B&B's in the area, we will enjoy dinner and social at the Award-Winning Texas favorite, Kloesel's Steakhouse. Sunday we will travel through the rural communities of Komensky, Moravia and St. John on our way to lunch at Schulenburg's historic Sengelmann Hall. The Schulenburg Chamber of Commerce will then guide us on a tour of the local Famous Painted Churches of Texas including Praha, Dubina, High Hill and Ammannsville before we all depart for our respective homes.

Because lodging options are very limited in these rural areas, it is highly recommended that reservations be made NOW.

Built by Lucas and Gretchen Rehmet in 1896, it has been lovingly restored and remodeled by hosts Don and Cindy McIntosh to capture the grandeur of yesteryear while offering the amenities of today.

***Old Kasper House Bed & Breakfast, 219 Ave C, Shiner, TX 77984

Built in 1905, the house was the model home of local building contractor, alderman, and cotton ginner John F. Kasper and his wife, Mary, where old-world traditions were practiced and preserved from 1898 to 1960, including bee-keeping, wine-making, and woodworking. In 1986, this lovely Victorian-style home was converted into the Old Kasper House Bed & Breakfast with several different homes and cottages to choose from. Each place has bedrooms, private baths, and living and dining areas with unique character and personality. The main Victorian House also has a spacious dining room where breakfast is served each day.

Saturday, August 21:

Lunch: Shiner Restaurant & Bar - Built by entrepreneur William Green, Jr. this building housed Shiner's first surgical hospital upstairs. Downstairs was a drugstore and saloon with an impressive hand-carved bar. It is now the home of Shiner Restaurant & Bar.

Dinner: Kloesel's Steakhouse & Below the Tracks Bar in Moulton – In 1970, Harvey & Diana Kloesel began their restaurant business located on the site of the Moore Hotel, a historical landmark built by Samuel Moore, one of the original founders and settlers of Moulton. They offer premium cuts of choice aged beef which Harvey personally selects, cuts, trims and cooks. Named Restaurateur of the Year in 2000 and 2007, and inducted into the Texas Restaurant Association Hall of Honor in 2009. Below the Tracks Bar offers a full bar, dancing/Karaoke, Happy Hour 5-7:00.

Sunday, August 22:

Lunch: Sengelmann Hall in Schulenburg - Sengelmann Hall is a restored 1890's Texas dance hall, restaurant, saloon, biergarten & Czech bakery in historic downtown Schulenburg. The bar is an exact replica of the mahogany bar that adorned Sengelmann Hall from 1894 until the 1940's and the dance floor is the original 115 year-old, long leaf pine.
