This year the annual nautical cruise will depart from the pier located behind the Clam Shack at 227 Clinton Ave. Falmouth, MA on Sunday, August 16th. Free parking is available in the Clam Shack's parking lot. The Liberté, a 74foot 3-masted schooner, will sail for 2 hours in the waters off Cape Cod. Light refreshments will be available on board. Please plan to arrive at 2:30PM for a 3:00PM departure. Of course dress comfortably but appropriately for potential sea spray depending on the weather.

After the cruise we will drive about a block to the famous Coonamessett Inn at 311 Gifford Street for a half hour cocktail period to stabilize our sea legs. The Inn is renown in this area as the ultimate in quaint New England charm and exquisite food.



The schooner can accommodate only 49 people so please respond early. All replies must be received by Saturday, August 8 with a check made payable to Minute Man Section, MBCA and your choice(s) of entrees.
