MBCA/SFBA GOING TO THE DOGS

In the beginning...

It all began with a dream—the dream of creating the first guide dog training school on the West Coast. It was a dream shared by Lois Merrihew and Don Donaldson, who volunteered their efforts along with many others. They recognized the need to help wounded servicemen who would return from World War II without their sight. They believed in the potential of dogs to serve as guides for the blind.

The school was incorporated in May 1942. A German Shepherd named **Blondie** was one of the first dogs trained. **Blondie** had been rescued from a Pasadena dog pound. She was later paired with Sgt. Leonard Foulk, the first serviceman to graduate from the new school.

Today...

In 1947, the school moved from Los Gatos to their present 11-acre location in San Rafael. They now have 2 locations—San Rafael and Oregon—and have graduated more than 10,000 teams since 1942.

Both campuses house students in exceptional dormitory facilities which include dining rooms, exercise rooms, libraries, computer rooms, and social areas. Both are located near major metropolitan centers, providing graduated training from quiet rural areas to congested city streets and public transit. The dogs and puppies are cared for in meticulous kennels and state-of-the-art veterinary clinics. Labrador Retrievers, Golden

While not all of our members have the four-wheel drive vehicles that will be required to participate in the driving portion of this event, our **Off-Road Driving Adventure** will be an enjoyable day for both drivers and spectators alike. 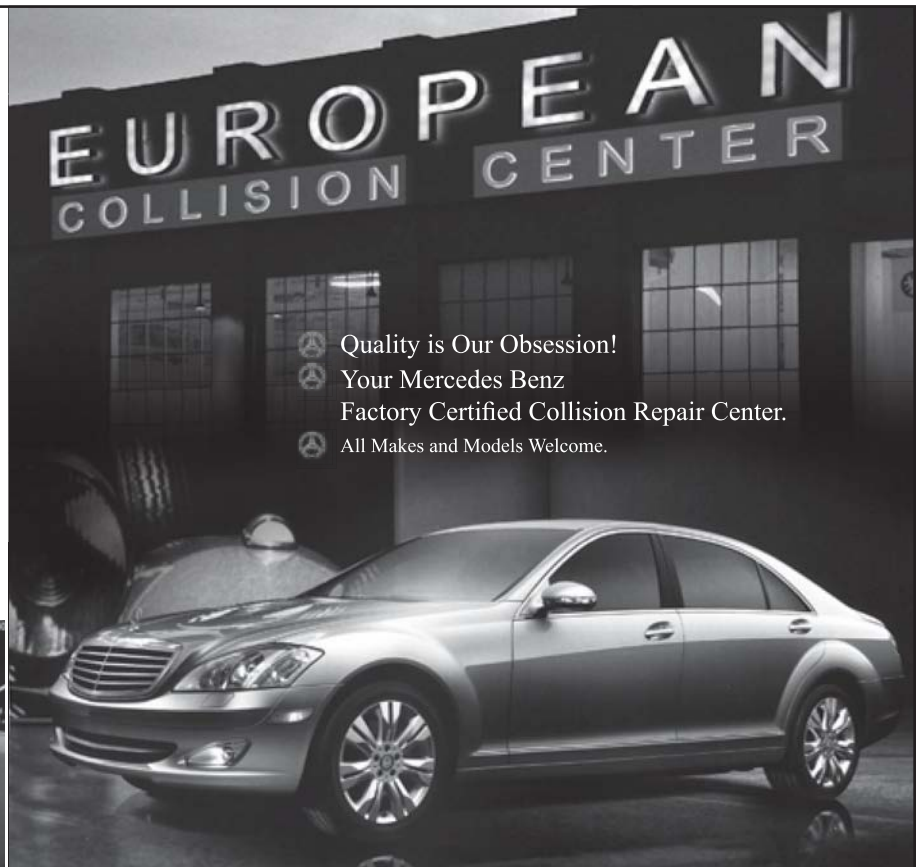

OUR DAY WITH BEER AND STONE

“Honorary BeerMaster” certificates were awarded to our 15 members who braved the stormy weather on March 26 to attend the Anheuser-Busch Brewmaster’s Tour in Fairfield. We got to sample a number of the many Budweiser and other beers on this informative tour organized by ex-President Robert Schilling and expertly guided by Mike Holloway. Built in 1976 on 170 acres, the plant has a floor area of 700,000 square feet.

In 1857, Adolphus Busch immigrated to the U.S. from Germany. Eberhard Anheuser, another German immigrant, had purchased a St. Louis brewery in 1860. Busch followed the time-honored tradition of advancement by marrying Anheuser’s daughter Lilly, joining his father-in-law’s brewery as a salesman, later becoming a partner and finally president of the company. President for 33 years, he is considered to be the founder of the company.

Budweiser beer was first brewed in 1876. A combination of art and science, brewing begins in large mash tanks where ground barley malt is mixed with water. Milled rice is cooked in water and combined with the malt. Natural enzymes in the malt break down the grain’s starch into fermentable sugars. After straining, this wort is transferred into brew kettles and brought to a boil. Natural hops are added for flavor, aroma, and character. Yeast is then added to the cooled wort in the primary fermentation tanks to convert the fermentable sugars to carbon dioxide and alcohol. During this stage of the brewing process, the wort becomes beer.

Beechwood chips are spread on the bottom of lager tanks; the beer is then transferred into the tanks. A portion of freshly yeasted wort is added. Lagering is part of secondary fermentation in which the yeast settles on the wood chips and works until the beer is completely fermented. As this occurs, the beer is naturally carbonated and its final flavor develops. Bottling and shipping follow. Our lengthy tour took us through the entire process.

We then took an enjoyable lunch break at the Blue Frog brewpub nearby.

Duracite Custom Countertops was our next stop for a tour of their Fairfield facility organized by our section’s Hospitality Chair Kara Pannu and graciously hosted by Duracite’s President, Fadi Halabi (a club member).

We toured several acres of outdoor and indoor areas where a huge selection of large granite and other stone slabs were displayed. We saw where and how the slabs were accurately measured and cut to precise tolerances using a state-of-the-art German-made Kuka multi-axis robotic cutting machine.

In addition to granite from the U.S., Brazil, and India, Duracite also provides Soapstone, wood and man-made surfaces—Corian and Zodiac by DuPont, Vetrazzo and Cambria. Duracite manufactures and installs (using their own trained technicians) the custom countertops ordered at Costco, Lowe’s, and Home Depot stores and also works with contractors. In their Fairfield showrooms, the finished products can be seen in the display kitchens and baths. We got an education in stone and granite installations.
